ATTENDANCE NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

- The district has recently updated our Attendance Notification System. Parents/Guardians will begin to receive a daily text message if your child has been marked absent or tardy.
- For your convenience, you may respond to the text message with your excuse if you wish. You can also still provide an excuse by phone call, email or a good old-fashioned note.
- As with other text messages, you can OPT OUT by simply replying STOP.
- You will also receive a monthly text message known as an Attendance Postcard. This gives you information on your child's attendance to date for the year. You will easily see if your child's attendance is on track, or if your child is struggling with attendance. If that's the case, we'd like to help, and encourage you to reach out to us.
- You may have received an initial message last week. We apologize that you received this without prior notice it was not our intention. We appreciate your patience as we move forward in our efforts to support our families and continue to make student attendance a high priority.

2023-2024 POSSIBLE RETENTIONS

SUMMER SCHOOL

- If your child qualifies for summer school and potential promotion to the next grade level, the guidance department will be in contact with parents.
- Summer School cost was \$116 per course last year and it may increase this year.
- A student may enroll in two courses maximum.
- Starpoint CSD will host summer school this summer and transportation is the parent's responsibility as the WCSD does not provide transportation for summer school.
- There will be a short window of time for summer school registration.
